34th Annual Moo Moo Classic
September 12, 2026

CATTLE SHOW GUIDELINES

1. Exhibitor Age Requirements: 9 years old to 21 years old by Sept. 1 2026. Exhibitors who have graduated from high school will not be eligible to participate in showmanship.
2. Steers and Commercial Heifers will be shown by weight.
3. Registered heifers will be shown by age and will need registration papers in the exhibitor's name at check-in to be eligible for the registered heifers show. If not, they will be placed in the commercial heifer show and shown by weight. Registered Heifers will show with their respective breeds provided there are at least 7 entered. If there are less than 7, those heifers will show in All Other Breeds registered heifers. Percentage breeds such as % Simmental or Shorthorn Plus will show with their respective purebreds provided there are at least 7 heifers entered.
4. All entries must have a form of identification (tattoo and/or tag number).
5. All animals presented for exhibition purposes shall be accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate stating that these animals are from herds not under quarantine and are apparently free of all infectious, contagious, or communicable diseases.
6. Entries are open to the world.
7. Check-in will be Saturday morning from 7:00-8:30 am.
8. There is no limit to the number of entries per exhibitor.
9. Show will be Jackpot style.
10. All entries must be entered into showportal.
11. Showmanship will be broken up into 4 groups by the discretion of the show committee.
12. Show will start at 10 am. Show order (Showmanship, Registered Heifers Divisions, Commercial Heifers, and Steers)
13. Show will not be classified as a fitting show or a blow and go show. Fitting of the animal is up to the exhibitor.
14. Classification of registered heifers is as follows:
 - Class I Junior heifer calves born January 1, 2026 and after
 - Class II Winter heifer calves born November 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025
 - Class III Fall heifer calves born September 1, 2025 through October 31, 2025
 - Class IV Summer heifers born July 1, 2025 through August 31, 2025
 - Class V Spring yearling born April 1, 2025 through June 30, 2025
 - Class VI Early Spring yearling born January 1, 2025 through March 31, 2025
 - Class VII Mature Winter Heifers born November 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024
 - Class VIII Mature Fall Heifers born September 1, 2024 through October 31, 2024
15. Commercial heifers will be weighed but should conform to the ages listed above.

NOTE: Tie space in the barn is first come, first serve and the rest will have to tie to the trailer. Exhibitors who plan to stall in the barn need to bring shaving for tie down.
