Show Schedule

Friday, February 7th

2pm: Barn opens for tack and livestock arrival

4pm - 7pm: Weigh-In

9pm: Barn Closes

Saturday, February 8th

7am: Barn Opens

9am: Show Starts (Showmanship followed by Purebred Barrow, Market Barrows, Purebred Gilts, Market Gilts)

Show Rules

1. Exhibitors 12th grade and younger are eligible to show. Pre-Club exhibitors must be able to exhibit his/her animal without the assistance of an adult or older exhibitor in the ring.
2. All Georgia State Livestock Rules and Regulations will be followed. Show is open to ALL states.
3. All hogs must have a readable ear tag.
4. All hogs must be blood tested PRV and Brucellosis negative within 45 days of the show and have an official health certificate. All out-of-state hogs must have a prior permit number on the health certificate.
5. Exhibitors must show their own hog in class. If the exhibitor has more than one hog in a class they can have another exhibitor show for them. This must be cleared with show officials before showing.
6. **Entry Fee**
 - a. The entry fee per animal is \$30.00
7. **Pen Fee**
 - a. Pen fee is \$10.00 per pen (Pens will be assigned by show officials prior to show)
 - b. You may show off the trailer but will be first come, first serve for parking.
8. **Showmanship**
 - a. Showmanship \$10.00 entry fee.
 - b. Each exhibitor must show their own animal in showmanship. The animal must be entered in the show and owned by the exhibitor.
 - c. Showmanship Divisions: Novice, Intermediate, Junior, Senior

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9. Purebred Gilt Show

- a. Purebred gilts will be shown by age.
- b. A minimum of 5 entries must be received to make a Breed Show. If less than 5 entries are received for a registered breed, those entries will be shown as AOB.
- c. Papers must be in the exhibitor's name and presented at check-in.

10. Purebred Barrow Show

- a. Purebred barrows will be shown by weight.
- b. A minimum of 5 entries must be received to make a Breed Show. If less than 5 entries are received for a registered breed, those entries will be shown as AOB.
- c. Papers must be in the exhibitor's name and presented at check-in.

11. Market Hog Show

- a. Market Gilts and Barrows will be shown separately.
- b. Animals will be weighed and divided into classes by show officials. After the animal leaves the scales there will be no re-weighs.
- c. Exhibitors must show their own hog in class. If the exhibitor has more than one hog in a class they can have another exhibitor show for them. This must be cleared with show officials before showing.

12. Class Breakdown and Payout will be based on the number of entries received.

13. No refunds will be given.

14. The Arrowhead Classic Rules Committee reserves the right to interpret all rules. Decisions of the judge and the rules committee will be final. After pigs have been checked in and left the scales, no changes will be made. Decisions made by the show committee will be final.
