1. This show is open to 4-H and FFA members through 12th grade in school plus pre-club age children in grades 1-4 from any state.
2. Animals must be owned by the exhibitor on or before December 5, 2026.
3. The deadline to enter is December 5, 2026 at 12am, no late entries will be accepted.
4. Entry fees are \$30.00 per animal and \$5.00 for each species for showmanship. Fees are non-refundable.
5. Ewes and Does must be ear-tagged with the identification number entered on the entry form by December 5, 2026. All must have a USDA approved scrapie tag in the ear.
6. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspections is required with the individual identification. Any animals exhibiting symptoms of Foot Rot, Scabies, Contagious Ecthyma (soremouth), Cutaneous Fungal Lesions, Scrapie, or any other Infectious disease will not be permitted to show. The show committee reserves the right to disqualify animals due to health concerns.

7. All does must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
8. There is no limit to the number of animals you may enter.
9. Showmanship is open to all exhibitors. Classes will be combined based on numbers in each grade. There will be at least 4 showmanship buckles per species.
10. Ewes and does will be shown by weight.
11. Showing off the trailer is allowed, please provide your own power source if you choose this option.
12. Pens are \$10.00 per stall, shavings are **NOT** included.
No tack stalls will be available until all entries are in, then they will be on a first come first serve basis.
13. Exhibitors must show their own animals unless they have more than 1 per class. A current 4-H or FFA member entered in the show may show the second animal.
14. The FCYFA nor the Fannin County School System will not be responsible for loss or damage to any animal, supplies, or equipment.
15. The Holiday Classic Committee reserves the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Show Committee are final.
16. Does and ewes can arrive on Friday from 4:00 pm till 8:00 pm or from 7:00 am -9:00 am Saturday. Weigh in will be 7:00am- 9:00am on Saturday
The barn will be locked at 8:30pm Friday night until 6:30am Saturday morning.
17. Premiums will be based on entries.
18. Concessions will be available for both breakfast and lunch.
