

Madison County Fair Rules and Regulations

1. Dairy Heifers born between **MARCH 1, 2023 and AUGUST 20, 2024** are eligible to show. Heifers must weigh between 100 pounds and not more than 1,250. All heifers must be dehorned. **Heifers not dehorned will be disqualified.** All animals must have official health papers when checked in on Friday that meet the state requirements.
 2. Only current 4-H and FFA members are eligible (9 yrs. and older). Any member that has graduated from high school is not eligible to show.
 3. A limit of **4** heifers is the maximum that a member can enter for the show.
 4. Animals must be shown by their owner unless permission is granted from the chairman of the show.
 5. This is a **blow and go show**. No fitting please.
 6. Barn opens **THURSDAY**, September 26th from 12:00 pm until 4:00 p.m. **All animals must be in place by 5:00 p.m.** (Check-in from 3:00 pm to 5:00pm).
 7. **There will be stall assignments based on schools/counties. Do NOT use this space for tack.** All tack must be set up outside the barn.
 8. The show will be held on **THURSDAY**, September 26th at 6:00 p.m., starting with showmanship (youngest to oldest), and followed by weight.
- Showmanship classes will be based on grade in school and divided as close to equal as possible based on the number of entries. **Four Showmanship Classes will be used.**
Placings will be through the top 5 of each class. For Final Drive – A Grand and a Reserve Champion overall will be at the end of the heifer classes.
9. **Due to limited space, once the barn reaches capacity, all other entries will be returned.**
 10. All exhibitors are expected to keep a clean and neat stall area or will risk the forfeiture of all prize money. Limited tack space will be provided outside of the show barn. ****Generators are not required but are definitely recommended****
 11. A \$25.00 entry fee per animal will be charged at the time of entry. Showmanship will be a \$10 fee per exhibitor. Payment is made online through the Show Portal.
 12. Four classes of showmanship will be divided as equally as possible by grade at the discretion of the show committee.
 13. **No bedding (straw or hay) will be allowed in the barn.**
 14. **No head chutes are allowed.**
 15. All animals will be exhibited at the owner's risk. Every precaution will be taken to prevent damage to animals but neither the Fair Association nor those in charge of the show assume the responsibility in the case of loss or damage to any exhibit.
 16. Show will follow state rules.
